Dear Camp10 Parent,

It's our great privilege to partner with you on Camp1O, the study abroad ministry of Corban University and Teach Every Nation. Below, please see a testimony from a Camp1O 2O17 parent. We hope this narrative is an encouragement to you as you consider God's purpose for your son or daughter.

I spoke to a team member of Camp1O to send my sixteen year old son to South Africa to study abroad [in 2O17]. Initially, my wife and I felt reluctance to permit him to attend. This was particularly true in that he has juvenile diabetes and we were not knowledgeable of the living conditions, medical facilities, and his physical reactions to this foreign environment.

My son was excited about the opportunity. My wife was still was not totally on board, even as he boarded the plane. Our family prayed and did what every parent has to do at some point – place your child in the hands of our Savior and Lord Jesus Christ. He can provide both you and your child with the strength, protection, and guidance needed one day at a time.

Camp1O was a life changing event for my son. He has matured spiritually and emotionally. Had we not permitted him to attend, my son would have been denied an experience which has transformed his life. Although sending him appeared to be an obstacle given his age, inexperience, and with his medical limitations, it was actually an opportunity.

When you transfer your trust from yourself to Christ, obstacles become opportunities and problems become possibilities. My son still maintains friendships with former team members and is considering Corban University as a postsecondary option. Camp1O was one of the greatest moments in my son's life and the greatest decision we made in placing him on a positive spiritual path he was ordained for from birth.
